The UPLIFT V2 is a durable standing desk with a maximum load of 355 pounds. It's designed with a stability wedge and inverted legs for sturdiness. While many desks feature an anti-collision system, this model stands out

from the pack because it also has a keypad lock to keep the desk from moving until deactivated, which helps prevent accidents within your home or office.

This standing desk has more customization options than most models, and it's available in multiple desktop finishes as well as with different options for keypads. This device has a custom accessory mounting system complete with 48 threaded mounting holes to allow for the addition of desk accessories like UPLIFT's sidecar shelf, foot hammock, mountable surge protector, and more.

Featuring a one-touch adjustment system with up to four saved heights, the UPLIFT V2 will adjust to your preferred height with just a single touch. For an additional cost, you can purchase the UPLIFT Bluetooth Adapter, which allows you to control your desk via the UPLIFT Desk App.

This model from IKEA is ideal for users looking to get a large desk at a lower price, as it measures 63 inches wide and 31 1/2 inches deep. However, with a maximum load of just 110 pounds, this desk may not be ideal for those with a lot of heavy equipment.

It's made with a steel base and a particleboard and fiberboard top that's easy to assemble. As it's a manual crank desk, it allows users to place the desk anywhere in their home since an electrical outlet isn't required. IKEA's website states that a benefit to this desk's manual hand crank is that it gives you the option to not only move your body from a sit/stand position but also work your arms as you adjust the height. The hand crank can be installed on

either side of the desk, and, when not in use, it can slide under the table to help maintain the sleek design.

When looking for a standing desk, it's important to consider height adjustability, max weight load, stability, and functionality in your space. Our top overall pick the UPLIFT V2 Standing Desk offers a range of customizable options – size, aesthetics, and accessories – that we've found to be unmatched by competitors.

Things To Consider When Buying Standing Desks

Height Adjustability Range: To achieve the best results with your standing desk, you'll want to find one with the correct height adjustability. According to the founder of The Ergonomic Expert Karen Loesing, a desk that can lower to 24 inches is suitable for almost all height ranges. Meanwhile, anyone who is more petite, she says, should consider a desk that can lower to 22 inches. Many desks offer programmable sizes, making it easier to switch between your sit/stand position. However, if those heights aren't right for your height, you may not be getting the maximum benefits.

Desktop Size and Max Weight Load: For the most optimized work setup, you'll want to make sure you're choosing a desktop size that takes into consideration all the equipment you'll be using. Loesing says, "You need to remember if working in standing that you may likely need to raise your monitor(s) as well so you may have to purchase monitor arm(s) or have height adjustable monitor stands."

The max weight load is also important to know, as it refers to the maximum amount the desk can support without breaking or malfunctioning. If your space requires a dual-monitor setup or the use of heavy equipment, you'll want to choose a desk that can support that weight and still provide you with the functionality of a standing desk.

Ease of Assembly: An often overlooked factor is the ease of setup prior to usage. Some desks are heavier than others, so make sure that the setup process doesn't require you to lift beyond your limits.

Additional Features: While additional features like a cable management system or a keyboard tray aren't considered must-haves by experts, they're something to take into consideration when you make your purchase. If you're unsure of what your needs will be down the road, it may be wise to opt for a desk that you can later customize or supplement with add-ons.

How We Chose the Best Standing Desks

To arrive at this list of the best standing desks, we sought the expert knowledge of Karen Loesing, a licensed physical therapist assistant, certified ergonomics assessment specialist, and founder of The Ergonomics Expert, a business based in Los Angeles, California, that provides ergonomics consultations. We then explored both user and professional reviews and compared price, height adjustability, size, stability, ease of assembly, and customization options, which we used to select our top picks.


