





Dyson and Shark are companies that are known for making vacuums with new technology and features. They also both sell models specifically engineered with pet owners in mind. For instance, most of Shark's vacuums are equipped with anti-hair wrap technology to prevent pet hair from tangling around the device's brush bar. Similarly, Dyson vacuums come with a tangle-free turbine tool to remove pet hair from carpet and furniture.

For a more precise cleaning performance, some of Dyson's latest models, like the V15 Detect and the V11, include a self-adjusting design that automatically changes its suction power to suit varying floor types, whether it be high-pile, low-pile, or medium-pile carpet, or hard floors. Shark's standout feature is its detachable Lift-Away technology, which allows its corded models to convert into portable canister vacuums to handle above-floor areas like stairs and upholstery.

Other than vacuum cleaners, Shark makes mops, hair dryers, and air purifiers. Dyson's product line includes hair dryers, hair straighteners, air purifiers, and lights.

Dyson vs. Shark: Available Vacuums

Since 2018, Dyson has been focused on making cordless vacuums. While the company also sells canister-style and corded upright vacuums, most of the models in its lineup are cord-free. The company only offers one corded model line: the Dyson Ball.

Shark, however, makes numerous corded models, including upright and stick lines. Shark's extensive offering also includes a few robot vacuums, which range in price from \$249.99 to \$649.80.

Dyson and Shark vacuums are both sold on their respective company's websites. They're also available in major retail stores, including Target, Bed Bath & Beyond, and Home Depot. Dyson has demo stores in select cities so people can try out the brand's vacuums prior to purchasing them.

Dyson vs. Shark: Price

When it comes to cost, Dyson vacuums are typically the more expensive choice. The three Dyson models that made our Best Vacuums of 2023 list, the Dyson Ball Animal 2 Upright Vacuum, the Dyson V15 Detect Cordless Vacuum, and the Dyson V11 Animal Vacuum, cost \$500, \$600, and \$700, respectively. A higher-end vacuum from the brand, the Dyson Outsize Absolute+, has a price tag of \$899.99.

In comparison, Shark vacuums range in price from \$150 to \$400. An upright vacuum from the company, the Shark Rotator Lift-Away Upright Vacuum with PowerFins and Self-Cleaning Brushroll, costs \$299.99. Meanwhile, the Dyson Ball Animal 2, Dyson's comparable upright vacuum, sells for \$499.99. Of all the upright vacuums we evaluated in our rankings, this price tag is the steepest.

For cordless stick vacuums, Dyson's entry-level vacuum, the Dyson V8, costs \$399.99, while its latest model, the Dyson V15 Detect, sells \$699.99. The prices of Shark's cordless vacuums fall between \$149.99 and \$449.99.



The Dyson Ball Animal 2 Vacuum and the Shark Navigator Lift-Away ADV Upright Vacuum are both corded upright vacuums with powerful suction. Similarly, they use swivel steering to maneuver around obstacles and furniture.

The Shark sells for \$239.99, a price tag that's \$260 less than the Dyson, making it a better option for those on a budget. The Navigator has LED headlights to help reveal hidden dust and debris, a feature that the Dyson Ball model doesn't include. It's also worth noting that the Shark is five pounds lighter than the Dyson.

The Dyson, however, ties at No. 4 in our Best Vacuums of 2023 list. The Shark doesn't place in our rating. The Dyson's 35-foot cord is 10 feet longer than the Shark's, meaning it can cover a greater distance while remaining plugged into the same outlet.

The Dyson's dirt cup holds 1.1 liters of debris, which is a larger capacity than the Shark's canister. Additionally, the bin has an easy-to-empty design. The touch of a button activates a point-and-shoot mechanism, expelling collected waste directly into the trash can, so you don't have to touch dirt or dust.

Dyson vs. Shark: Bottom Line

Three Dyson vacuums earn a spot in our Best Vacuums of 2023 list, while no Shark models place in our rankings. Dyson specializes in producing cordless vacuums and only sells one upright model worldwide. Shark, on the other hand, has a more extensive offering, which includes several upright models, in addition to its lineup of stick vacuums.


Shark vacuums are a more suitable choice for those on a budget because Dyson vacuums tend to be pricier. All Shark units come with a limited five-year warranty, while Dyson provides a five-year warranty for its corded vacuums and a two-year warranty for its cordless models.

For people with larger homes, it's worth mentioning that Dyson vacuums are equipped with larger dust cups. The brand's cordless vacuums also boast a longer run time. For instance, when set in standard mode, the Dyson V15 Detect runs for an hour, while the Shark Anti Hair Wrap Cordless Stick Vacuum Cleaner lasts for 40 minutes.


In general, Dyson vacuums are lighter and more compact than Shark models, making them easier to maneuver around your home.


