# 8 Best Ironing Boards of 2024





Look for ironing boards that are user-friendly and offer features to make it easier to keep your clothing, linens, and other fabrics wrinkle-free and ready for use. Some models are packed with features - like an iron rest, a garment rack, or an adjustable height - while others offer a more compact design to better accommodate travelers or those who live in a small space. We compiled a list of eight top options to help you find the best ironing board to fit your needs.

# **Brabantia Ironing Board C** »

The Brabantia Ironing Board C earned the spot as our best overall ironing board for several reasons. This model offers a work area that is 48.82 inches long by 17.72 inches wide, providing users with enough space to iron most shirts without needing to move them. The ecru-colored cotton cover gives this model a contemporary look, while the four-legged alloy steel frame works to ensure a stable surface as you iron your clothes.

Kim Rodriguez, a personal stylist and the owner of KR Personal Style, shares that she is a fan of Brabantia ironing boards. Some of the features that she loves about this specific board include the iron holder, the built-in rack for hanging garments, and the height adjustment options. You can adjust it between 29.53 and 38.58 inches tall, which accommodates users of different heights and those who may prefer to iron when sitting down.

While this model is not the least expensive ironing board on our list, it's less expensive than many of the other larger boards with similar features, such as the Rowenta Pro Compact Ironing Board and the Bartnelli Pro Luxury Ironing Board.

# **Ikea Ruter Ironing Board »**



### PROS:

- Adjustable height

If you're looking for an ironing board that will get the job done without breaking the bank, consider this model from Ikea. The Ruter Ironing Board offers a 42.5-inch-by-13-inch working area. Its 100% cotton cover is removable and machine-washable for easy cleaning. Adjust the height of the board between 30.25 and 35.5 inches to find a comfortable working position for ironing your garments. For durability, the ironing board is designed with a powder-coated steel frame.

While the budget-friendly price can make this a good ironing board for infrequent use, it does lack some of the bells and whistles that you'll find with more expensive models. As an example, there is no iron rest on the board.

Liz Teich, a personal and commercial fashion stylist and the creator of the blog "The New York Stylist," explains that this can be frustrating and that there is "nothing worse than having nowhere to put the iron down other than on top of the garment you're ironing." The working area for this board is also considerably smaller than the other standard ironing boards on our list, which are all at least 48 inches long and 15 inches wide with some being even larger.



**Best for Small Spaces** 

Whitmor Tabletop Ironing Board »



If you're tight on space and don't have room to store a standard ironing board, take a look at this tabletop model from Whitmor. The board is a more compact size with legs that fold flat for easier storage. The flat surface for ironing is 29 inches long by 12 inches wide, so you'll have to make accommodations and shift garments around more when ironing. However, if you don't have a lot of space, the design of this model, along with the retractable hook that allows the board to hang on a closet rod or behind a door, may be worth the trade-off for you.

This model also offers a steel mesh top with ventilation holes. These holes are designed to make it easier to remove wrinkles from your garments as the steam circulates through the board and the clothing item you're ironing. The bases of the folding legs have no-skid protectors to keep the board from

sliding as you work and protect your tabletops against scratches. With its retail price of \$19.99, this ironing board is also the least expensive model to make our list.

# **Best for Travel**

# Gorilla Grip Ironing Pad »

If you need a way to iron your clothing while traveling, consider the Gorilla Grip Ironing Pad. You can fold or roll the pad when it's not in use, making it possible to pack it in your suitcase for your next business or leisure trip. Its compact design also makes it a suitable option for individuals with minimal storage space in their homes. Once unrolled or unfolded, the ironing pad offers a 24-inch-by-28-inch work area.

Simply place the pad on a tabletop, countertop, or washing machine, and it will be ready to use. It features a slip-resistant backing to keep it in place along with six magnets to help it adhere to washing machines and other magnetic surfaces.

The Gorilla Grip Ironing Pad has a silicone surface that reflects an iron's heat, helping to release wrinkles from clothing and linens more quickly. Despite its lightweight design, it's still thick enough to protect the surfaces beneath it and withstand several years of use.

# Bartnelli Pro Luxury Ironing Board - Extra Wid...



### PROS:

With its generously sized work surface of 51 inches by 10 inches, the Bartnelli Pro Luxury Ironing Board may be the ideal choice for those looking for an extra-wide model. Beyond its larger size, the board is designed with features that make it easy to use and effective at releasing wrinkles from clothing and linens. The top of the board is made from a metal mesh material that makes it possible for steam to move through the board as you

work to speed the process along. A 100% cotton cover with foam padding is wrapped around the metal mesh. This material is ideal for preventing clothes from getting stuck to the board while also being able to hold up against the heat generated by an iron.

An iron (or steam iron) rest and a hanging rack are integrated into the design of this model. Users can adjust the wobble-free, wide legs to set the height of the board anywhere between 30 and 38 inches based on their comfort level. When not in use, the legs collapse, folding the board nearly flat for more compact storage.

# Rowenta Pro Compact Ironing Board »



### PROS:

The Rowenta Pro Compact Ironing Board is a favorite of both Teich and Rodriguez. This model's iron rest doubles as a space to hang clothes as you're working. Another key feature of the board is the foldout linen rack where users can place their folded items or garments that are waiting to be steamed. (The linen rack can hold a steam generator.)

One of the things that Teich likes the most about this model is that it has a more compact and space-saving design while still offering a large 54-inch-by-18.5-inch ironing surface. Beyond the legs that allow the board to fold nearly flat, the edge of the ironing surface itself also folds, bringing the collapsed height of the board down to just 45 inches. The integrated wheels make it easier to move the board around the house or even to transport it to another location. Users can choose from four different height settings

between 26.5 inches and 33.5 inches. With all of the features this model has to offer, Teich calls it "the Mercedes of ironing boards."

### **Best Over-the-Door**

# Honey-Can-Do Over-the-Door Compact Foldin...



### PROS:

- ✓ Space-saving design

An over-the-door ironing board may be the right fit for those who are tight on space. Similarly, it could also be a suitable option for those who don't want the hassle of folding and unfolding a standard board every time they need it. The Honey-Can-Do Over-the-Door Compact Folding Ironing Board is designed to hang over standard-size doors.

When not in use, the board folds up against the back of the door, locking in place to prevent accidental injuries. The bumpers along the frame help protect the door against scratches and scrapes. When you're ready to work, the board pulls down, offering a 41-inch-by-14-inch surface for ironing clothes and other fabrics. It features a 7-millimeter foam pad and a 100% cotton cover.

## **Best for Steaming**

# Minky Ergo Plus Ironing Board »



### PROS:

- ✓ Lower rest for steam generator

If you use a steam generator to aid with wrinkle removal when ironing, you'll appreciate the design of the Minky Ergo Plus Ironing Board. It offers a lower rest designed to hold a steam generator and keep it in a convenient location as you iron. If you're not using a steam generator, you can use the rest to hold piles of folded clothes. In addition to the steam generator rest, this

model also offers a proprietary Ergo rest that allows users to place and retrieve their iron while maintaining a natural and comfortable arm position.

This ironing board offers a 48-inch-by-15-inch work area, which is moderately sized but not as large as some of the other models we reviewed. Another key feature of the board is its 100% cotton Prozone cover. The heat-reflective metal coating integrated into the cover works to effectively remove creases and wrinkles for an overall faster ironing experience.

# The Bottom Line

As you compare the different ironing boards on the market, consider how frequently you iron, where you do the majority of your ironing, how much storage space you have, whether or not you plan to bring the ironing board with you when traveling, and if there are any special features – such as an iron rest or height adjustment options – that you think would make your ironing experience more enjoyable. We chose the Brabantia Ironing Board C as our top pick because of its balance of user-friendly features – adjustable height, ironing rest, and large ironing surface area – combined with its more budget-friendly price.

# Things To Consider When Buying Ironing Boards

**Size:** One of the most important things to consider when purchasing an ironing board is its size. First, consider how much storage space you have available and make sure you choose a model that will fit in the space you have for it. If you have limited available space, choosing a more compact model may be the best option for you.

If space isn't a huge issue, then your primary concern should be the amount of working space the board provides. Smaller boards will give you less space to maneuver the iron and force you to move your clothes and linens around as you work. The standard size for an ironing board is about 49 inches long and 15 inches wide. However, if you foresee needing a larger space to work, you can find models that have a larger surface area. The Bartnelli Pro Luxury Ironing Board (our pick for the best extra-wide model), for example, offers a 51-inch-long-by-19-inch-wide surface area.

Rodriguez notes that considering weight is important "especially if you must carry the board across the house or upstairs for any reason." Similarly, if you're looking for a product that you can bring with you when traveling, finding something lightweight will also be important.

Frame and Board Materials: Next, don't forget to evaluate the materials used for the board itself, as well as its frame (when applicable). Irons generate a lot of heat, so it's important to look for boards made with materials that will withstand it. For this reason, if you're looking for a board with an iron rest, choosing a metal one will be a better option than one that is made from plastic. Ideally, ironing board covers should have thick padding, allowing you to press more heavily with your iron when needed.

You may also want to consider choosing a model with a reflective cover that will help heat clothing more quickly to smooth out wrinkles. However, you'll want to be careful when ironing more delicate materials on ironing boards with these covers, as reflective heat could damage such items. If you don't end up with an ironing board with a reflective cover, Teich shares that "if you put aluminum foil under the cover, you double your heat on both sides of the garment and save time."

The material used to make the frame of a standard ironing board is also important for stability and longevity. Look for models with rolled steel or aluminum frames. These materials are both strong and lightweight for the right balance of portability and stability when you work.

**Height Adjustability:** If you're purchasing a standard ironing board, you'll likely be able to adjust it between different heights. This is a convenient feature that allows each individual to set the board to the height that is most comfortable for them. However, while many models allow users to adjust the height, the specific range of height options varies between products.

Cindy Modler, the owner of Heartmycloset – a shop that sells custom, vintage-inspired clothing – shares that setting the ironing board to around the height of your hip should be comfortable for ironing while standing up. However, each individual's preferences and comfort levels may differ, so you may want to experiment to find the height that will be most comfortable for you and look for a model that will support that desire. If you prefer to iron while sitting down - as Modler does - then it will likely be even more important to check the range of height options to find one that will be comfortable for you to use.

**Foldability and Storage Options:** If you don't have a lot of space or don't iron frequently, finding a model that will fold up for easy storage is advisable. This way, you'll be able to place the ironing board against the wall or somewhere else where it will be out of the way when you're not using it.

Rodriguez mentions that over-the-door or tabletop ironing boards could be great options for those short on space. Models such as the Honey-Can-Do Over-the-Door Compact Folding Ironing Board and the Whitmor Tabletop Ironing Board from our list offer a more compact design than the larger folding models, such as the Brabantia Ironing Board C and the Bartnelli Pro Luxury Ironing Board. When storage space is tight, an ironing mat, such as the Gorilla Grip Ironing Pad, might also be worth considering.

**Additional Features:** Before finalizing your decision about which ironing board you'd like to purchase, consider what - if any - additional features are must-haves. One such feature that you might appreciate is an iron rest. With an iron rest, you can put the iron down without worrying about burning your garments or accidentally scorching the cover itself.

Some models also include an integrated shelf under the board. This can come in handy for holding clothing that has been ironed or needs to be ironed. Many shelves can also accommodate steam generators, which is a nice feature for those looking to use their ironing board for steaming. Modler points out that a safety lock is another important feature to look for so that you can feel confident that the board won't accidentally close as you're working.

**Warranty:** Purchasing an ironing board with a warranty can protect you against defective models. If still under the warranty period, the manufacturer should cover repairs or a replacement, preventing you from having to pay for a new model yourself. Not all ironing boards come with a warranty, and for those that do the specific length of coverage and warranty terms can vary significantly, so be sure to read up on what is included with the model you purchase.
