If you're shopping for a refrigerator that keeps fresh foods organized and easy to find, a bottom-freezer layout may be right for you. According to Antoni Singger, founder of Breezer Freezer, a bottom-freezer refrigerator can offer a number of benefits compared to other styles.

"They provide more convenient access to the fridge, reducing the need to bend down. This design also places the most-used items at eye level, improving efficiency," Singger says. "The freezer at the bottom allows for larger, more organized storage in the fridge compartment."

With the guidance of home and appliance experts like Singger, we researched the best bottom-freezer refrigerators and highlighted our recommendations below. Our top pick is the LG LRMVC2306 Smart Door-in-Door Refrigerator.

The LG LRMVC2306 Smart Door-in-Door Refrigerator – with its innovative and user-friendly features – is our top pick for the best bottom-freezer refrigerator. This model has a 23-cubic-foot capacity, a French door refrigerated section, and two drawers. The bottom drawer is for frozen foods, while the top drawer allows for more flexible storage options with five different temperature options. This model includes an integrated ice and water dispenser with a water filter that's hidden behind the shelves inside the door, helping to maximize the available storage space. When dispensing water, you can select the amount you need, and the unit will fill your cup or container as desired. The dispenser offers a 12.6-inch height, which is tall enough to fit a variety of cups, containers, and even water pitchers.

This LG LRMVC2306 is a Wi-Fi-enabled model that connects with LG's ThinQ app. With the app, you can monitor and adjust the temperature of the freezer and refrigerator from your phone and receive alerts about the appliance. This model features an InstaView panel. If you knock on the tinted glass two times, it lights up, making it possible to see inside the inner compartment without needing to open the door and let cold air out.

With a price tag less than \$1,000, the Hisense HRB171N6A Counter-Depth Bottom-Freezer Refrigerator offers a more budget-friendly option for those looking to enjoy the benefits of having a freezer on the bottom. This model has a 17.2-cubic-foot capacity and a more compact footprint than some of the larger models on our list. This may make it a better fit for individuals with a smaller kitchen or those looking for a second refrigerator for another room in their home. It's also a counter-depth model, so it won't stick out past the edges of the cabinets in your kitchen.

Hisense incorporates a variety of features to help users maximize the available storage space. For example, one of the shelves in the refrigerator section is adjustable to allow for different configuration options. The refrigerator door includes bins to store condiments and other items, including a section that's large enough to hold a full gallon of milk, water, or another beverage. The LED lighting in the refrigerator will help users locate what they're looking for. This model also has a "super cool function" and "super freeze function." If you need to cool or freeze food items in a pinch, simply press either of those buttons and colder air will be generated.

If you have a large family or need more storage space, take a look at the 27.9-cubic-foot GE Profile PVD28BYNFS 4-Door French-Door Refrigerator. This standard-depth model features an adjustable-temperature, refrigerated drawer above the freezer. Users can choose from four different temperature settings to create ideal storage conditions for wine, meat, cheese, or another item they wish to use it for. This product offers an integrated ice and water dispenser. The AutoFill feature uses sensors to detect the capacity of each container and automatically stop the flow of water once it's full.

The GE Profile PVD28BYNFS 4-Door French Door Refrigerator also has integrated Wi-Fi. Users can download GE's SmartHQ app on their phones, which will allow them to receive alerts, control the Turbo Cool and Turbo Freeze capabilities, and even customize the brightness of the internal LED lights. This bottom-freezer refrigerator has a fingerprint-resistant stainless finish and is an Energy Star qualified appliance.

If you live in an apartment or have a small kitchen, then the counter-depth GE GLE12HSPSS Bottom Freezer Refrigerator might be a good fit for you. This compact model is less than 2 feet wide and has an 11.9-cubic-foot capacity. The refrigerator compartment features a full-width, temperature-controlled drawer, providing optimal storage conditions for the different foods you need it to hold. Choose from three different temperature settings depending on whether or not you're storing meats, cheeses, drinks, or something else. There are also two pullout freezer drawers to help you keep your items organized and easily accessible.

This model also offers edge-to-edge, glass shelves to help you maximize the interior space to store more food items. The top shelf can slide back to accommodate bottles and other taller items when needed. There's also a bottle storage rack that extends down from the middle shelf of the refrigerator. It can hold up to five bottles, and, if not needed, it can be folded up to provide more shelf space for storing other items. To help users easily find what they're looking for in the refrigerator, this model also features bright LED interior lighting.

If you're looking for a smart refrigerator that comes with all the bells and whistles, then you might want to take a look at the Samsung RF23BB8 Bespoke 4-Door French

Door Refrigerator. This model connects with the SmartThings app, allowing you to monitor power usage and receive notifications about unexpected temperature fluctuations in the refrigerator or freezer.

In addition to the integration with the app, this bottom-freezer refrigerator also features Samsung's Family Hub. The Family Hub is a smart panel that can connect with other smart devices in your home, making it possible to view and manage calendars, play music, and even plan meals from the refrigerator. The Family Hub section will also let you view what's inside the fridge without opening the door.

The Samsung RF23BB8 Bespoke 4-Door French Door Refrigerator offers a modern look with customizable front panels. You can keep all four panels the same color or choose a combination of finishes for a unique look to make a statement in your kitchen. A few of the other standout features of this bottom-freezer refrigerator include the FlexZone Drawer with five temperature options, the built-in pitcher and water dispenser, and the dual ice maker.

The Bottom Line

"The most significant advantage [of bottom-freezer refrigerators] is the convenience of having your most-used items at eye level, reducing the need to bend or crouch," shares Samantha Odo, chief operating officer of Precondo.

All of the models in our list offer this benefit. However, they also differ in varying other aspects, including their capacity, the retail price, and any added features, impacting which model is right for you. We chose the LG LRMVC2306 Smart Door-in-

Door Refrigerator as our top pick because of its smart capabilities, adjustable organizational features, storage drawer with flexible temperature options, and more.

Things To Consider When Buying Bottom-Freezer Refrigerators

Dimensions: Before purchasing a new bottom-freezer refrigerator, you'll want to make sure the model you choose will fit in your kitchen. To determine this, you'll need to measure the dimensions of the space you have available and compare it to the dimensions of each model you're considering. When taking measurements, don't only measure the length and width of the space. If there are any cabinets over where the fridge will be placed, you'll also need to measure to determine the maximum height that will fit.

As you're shopping, you'll notice that there are counter-depth and standard-depth models available. As their name suggests, counter-depth refrigerators are designed to match the depth of your kitchen cabinets (between 23 and 27 inches deep). While these models may not offer as much storage space as standard-depth models, which are between 30 and 36 inches deep, they can provide a more built-in appearance. Also, since they won't stick out past the cabinets, they may be a better option for tighter kitchens.

Capacity: The capacity of a bottom-freezer refrigerator will directly affect how much food you'll be able to store in it. Capacity is measured in cubic feet, with the majority of appliances falling between 11 and 28 cubic feet. The larger the capacity, the more food that you'll be able to store in the refrigerator and freezer compartments.

The number of people in your home and the amount of food you like to keep on hand can help guide your search. Generally speaking, a fridge with a capacity between 18 and 22 cubic feet should be sufficient for households with up to four people, while homes with more members may want to look for a fridge with a capacity greater than 22 cubic feet.

As you compare the various models on the market, be sure to pay attention to not just the overall capacity but the capacity of the freezer and refrigerator sections

individually as well. This can help give you a better idea of whether or not the appliance will meet your needs.

Energy Efficiency: Samantha Odo, chief operating officer of Precondo, believes that energy efficiency is an important factor to keep in mind when shopping for a refrigerator. "A more energy-efficient model can lead to significant long-term savings on your utility bills," she says.

Odo recommends looking for models that have the Energy Star label "to ensure your refrigerator meets high standards for energy efficiency, ultimately reducing your carbon footprint and operating costs."

According to the United States Department of Energy, Energy Star certified models can save users more than \$220 over the lifetime of the refrigerator (assuming an average lifespan of 12 years). These models are just less than 10% more efficient than other models that meet the minimum energy-efficiency qualifications put in place by the federal government.

Features and Technology: Be sure to closely compare the features and technology of each model you're considering to make sure the refrigerator you choose matches your needs. "First and foremost, consider the interior layout," says Odo.

She adds: "Look for adjustable shelving, spacious door bins, and ample storage options to accommodate your specific needs. This flexibility is essential for organizing your groceries efficiently. Another vital feature is the freezer drawer. Opt for one with multiple compartments or sliding baskets for easy access and organization."

You might also want to look for models that come with an ice and water dispenser. If you like having cutting-edge appliances, then you have a number of new technologies to consider as well. For example, some refrigerators offer Wi-Fi connectivity, allowing you to monitor temperature settings, diagnose issues, and more via an app on your smartphone. Others may come equipped with advanced humidity or cooling features to extend the freshness of your food.

Finishes: Like other kitchen and laundry appliances, bottom-freezer refrigerators are available in a range of finish options. Some of the most common finishes include stainless steel, black stainless steel, and white, but you can also find models available in a range of other colors.

There are pros and cons to each material type that you'll want to consider alongside your individual preferences and budgetary needs. For example, while stainless steel is durable and resists corrosion, stainless refrigerators are often more expensive. White appliances, on the other hand, are less expensive and don't show smudges, but do stain more easily than some other finish options.

If you're looking to make a statement in your kitchen or want the flexibility of being able to change the finish of your refrigerator without purchasing an entirely new appliance, some models on the market offer changeable door panels that come in various finishes and color options for a truly customized look.
