The Keen Hyperport H2 Sandal earns the top spot on our list These water shoes are available in both men's and women's sizes with half-size options. The shoes feature an Aquagrip rubber outsole to keep users from slipping and sliding when walking on wet concrete, rocks, or other surfaces. Keen integrated a foam insole with arch support into the design of these sandals to provide cushioning and offer shock absorption.

These water shoes use a bungee lacing system, which makes them quick and easy to put on and take off while also ensuring a snug fit to keep rocks, sand, and other debris from getting into them. When they get wet, the open design and quick-dry lining will work together to help the shoes – and your feet – dry quickly. Four color combinations are available, and these shoes

are made without PFAs (perfluoroalkyl and poly-fluoroalkyl substances) or forever chemicals.

Costing less than \$20, the Seekway Water Shoes are the cheapest pair on our list. These water shoes are designed to be breathable and quick-drying. The polyester mesh outer material facilitates airflow and circulation, and the holes in the sole provide an escape for water to stop it from getting trapped in the shoe. Each shoe has a nonslip rubber outsole to provide both cushioning and traction as you walk on a variety of surface types. This pair is designed with side webbing to help prevent accidental cuts or scrapes when you're on the go.

After putting these on your feet, simply use the bungee closure to achieve a secure fit. The bungee design also means removing the shoes from your feet will be relatively quick and easy. Seekway offers these water shoes in a wide assortment of color options for both men and women. However, it's important to note that the available size options are more limited compared to other water shoes, as only a few half sizes are available.

The Xero Shoes Aqua X Sport is a top choice for women looking for water shoes for the beach, water sports, fishing, hiking, and more. The FeelTrue sole of these shoes is made from a durable rubber material to offer traction on multiple terrain types, making these shoes a suitable option to wear outside of the water as well. Beyond the FeelTrue sole, the design incorporates several other features to make it a top pick for use in or near the water. These shoes have a breathable mesh upper, drain holes in the toe area, a lining that dries quickly, and a nonabsorbent tongue.

Xero Shoes offers this footwear in three different color options. The pair is available in half sizes from 5 through 11, helping many users find the right fit for their feet. Xero Shoes says they should fit true to size. A few other key features of these water shoes include the wide toe box and the zero heel-to-toe drop to support healthy posture. As a lightweight water shoe – a size 7 weighs less than 6 ounces – you can easily toss these in a backpack without weighing yourself down during your adventures.

Men looking for water shoes may want to consider the Under Armour Men's UA Micro G Kilchis Fishing Shoes. These shoes are designed to offer excellent traction on rocks, wood decks, and other surfaces with their nonmarking rubber outsoles. Under Armour also kept comfort in mind when designing the shoes. There's a Micro-G foam midsole, which runs the entire length of the shoe, to provide cushioning and keep your feet from getting too sore.

The textile upper on each pair of shoes is breathable and quick-drying to keep your feet comfortable whether you're on land or in the water. The contoured midsole also helps keep your feet drier by supporting faster water drainage. Under Armour added synthetic overlays to the shoes to protect you from getting cuts and scrapes as you walk and explore.

Before packing for your next beach trip, pick up a pair of the Speedo Surf Knit Pro water shoes. When you step out of the water, these shoes will dry quickly and help prevent moisture from lingering around your feet. They feature hydrophobic rubber EVA insoles and breathable, fast-drying polyester uppers. The outsole is constructed from rubber and offers a special S-Trac design that helps disperse water with each step, providing better traction and making it easy to navigate a variety of surface types.

Speedo sells these shoes in both men's and women's sizes and a few color options. However, only full sizes are available, so you may need to determine

whether to size up or down based on the characteristics of your feet. Each shoe is also designed with a real pull tab on the heel to make it easier to put the shoes on or remove them, especially if they're wet.

They feature a breathable polyester upper and drainage holes that work together to help keep your feet from getting waterlogged. Removable shoelaces and an elastic band make it easy to put them on, take them off, and adjust their fit. The wide toe box offers plenty of space for your feet to move and adds to the overall stability of the shoes.

This option is designed to offer the right mix of water-friendly features with the support you'll need when hitting the trail. The shoes feature a Spider Rubber outsole to provide superior traction on a variety of surfaces. An EVA foam midsole delivers cushioning with each step, and a nylon shank (the piece of material between the insole and outsole) keeps your feet supported even when the terrain gets a bit rocky. To ensure your feet don't stay wet for long after hiking through a river or waterfall, the shoes' uppers are made from a synthetic material that dries quickly.

These hiking shoes are available in men's sizes with many half-size options. You can choose from two color options: black or bungee cord (brown with

blue). The hook-and-loop closures, elastic gores (panels that provide stretch), and plastic buckles help users get the shoes on and off quickly and easily. A peppermint-based treatment is also applied to the shoes to help control odors.



Astral sells attractive water shoes for both men and women. The Brewess 2.0 Water Shoes mimic the look of sneakers to keep you comfortable as you engage in water activities. The shoe comes in three color options to match the wearer's personal preferences. For men, there's carbon black, basalt black, and storm navy. Women can choose between onyx black, stone gray, and deep water navy.

Beyond their stylish appearance, these water shoes offer several additional features to keep feet comfortable as you trek through wet conditions. The brand's trademarked G. 15 Rubber + Flex Grip outsoles provide traction, the EVA foam midsole delivers cushioning, and the quick-dry canvas and 3D

airmesh uppers help your feet stay as dry as possible once you're out of the water.

### The Bottom Line

The ideal pair of water shoes for you will vary based on the intended activity, as well as your shoe size, style preferences, and more. The Keen Hyperport H2 Sandal earns the top spot in our list because of its quick-drying design, gripping rubber outsole, comfortable and shock-absorbing foam insole, and easy-to-use lacing system. We also like that this shoe is available in both men's and women's styles with half-size options. However, after you consider your specific needs, you may determine that one of our other recommendations is a better fit for you.

## **Things To Consider When Buying Water Shoes**

**Size and Fit:** Choosing water shoes that are appropriately sized for your feet is important. Just as you don't want to purchase a pair of hiking or running shoes that are too large, narrow, or wide, the same is true for water shoes. Dr. Brouyette notes that water shoes can stretch out in the water. Thus, she recommends opting for a

snugger rather than a looser fit when shopping for a new pair. You'll also want to consider whether you'll be wearing the shoes barefoot or if you'll be pairing them with some neoprene socks. If you plan to use neoprene socks, you may want to size up.

In addition to confirming that the shoes are sold in your size, you should also consider their weight. Heavier shoes can be less comfortable to wear and may end up slowing you down or impacting your ability to perform at peak levels. Similarly, they'll also add more weight to your bag when you aren't wearing them.

**Material:** Pay close attention to the material used to make each pair of water shoes that you're considering. John Mercer, Ph.D., a kinesiology professor at the University of Nevada Las Vegas, explains, "Water shoes are generally built with materials that do not absorb water. So fabrics like Lycra or mesh are common."

Roach highlights neoprene mesh as another excellent material for water shoes. He explains that this breathable material helps keep your feet dry and reduces moisture, preventing you from getting blisters. He says, "Neoprene is considered one of the best materials for water shoes due to its excellent water resistance, quick-drying properties, flexibility, and comfort."

Beyond choosing shoes constructed from water-resistant materials, you may also want to look for models that integrate drainage holes into their design. This will help prevent too much water from getting trapped in your shoes, causing discomfort and impacting the overall drying time for both the shoes and your feet.

**Traction and Grip:** "Look for shoes with a slip-resistant sole or tread pattern designed for wet and slippery surfaces," says Roach. He adds, "A rubber outsole is a popular choice for water shoes due to its durability, flexibility, and excellent traction properties."

Beyond the material of the outsole, John Wadley, vice president of product development at Xero Shoes, emphasizes the importance of the tread design itself. He explains, "A tread design optimized for wet environments will allow the water to evacuate from underneath the tread. Don't get a shoe that traps the water under the sole area."

Similarly, Wadley says "Think about a car tire tread pattern and how it encourages water to be directed away from the tread to maintain contact with the road. A good

water shoe does this to optimize grip for you during your water sports or other outdoor activities."

**Style and Color Options:** The pair of water shoes you choose should match your personal style and color preferences, as otherwise you're unlikely to wear them. As you shop, consider the overall appearance of the water shoes and whether or not they'll complement your look. Consider the type of activity you plan to wear them for, such as beach-going, hiking, or playing a water sport, and make sure they offer an appropriate style.

Beyond simply considering the aesthetics of the shoe, you should also consider the design elements that may make it a more practical choice for your chosen water-related activity. For example, Dr. Brouyette says to look for toe protection. She shares, "Make sure they are closed toes and protect against collisions with rocks or other underwater obstacles, providing an extra layer of safety."

Wadley highlights the lacing style as another important thing to consider as you shop. He explains, "A good water shoe will have a quick-draw cord mechanism that doesn't absorb water making it extremely difficult to untie once wet. A typical shoe lace will act as a sponge, soaking up water and then attracting dirt, grass, and weeds to stick to it once it's wet. You're much better off with a thin cord, quickdraw style closure that doesn't become more difficult to operate when wet, but also allows for that quick adjustability during your water sport or outdoor adventure."

In addition to considering customer ratings and recommendations from professional reviewers, we spoke with several experts in the industry: Nicole Brouyette, DPM, a board-certified podiatrist with Henry Ford Health in Michigan; John Mercer, Ph.D., a kinesiology professor at the University of Nevada Las Vegas; John Wadley, vice president of product development at Xero Shoes; and Derek Roach, owner of Flow Feet Orthopedic Shoes.
